A key part of her role will be implementing the School-Wide Positive Behaviour initiative, reinforcing our commitment to student wellbeing. We look forward to the positive impact Brittany will have in this space and the initiatives she will lead to support the wellbeing of our school community.

Amy, our dedicated Chaplain, is also an integral part of our Wellbeing Team, working with students at a whole-school level to promote a positive and supportive environment. In addition to her broader role, she is able to provide short-term **one-on-one support** to a small number of students who may need extra guidance.

As we begin the year, Amy will be reaching out to families she supported in 2024. The **Wellbeing Team** will collaborate with her to determine which students would benefit most from additional support. We value the important role Amy plays in student wellbeing and look forward to the positive impact she will continue to have across the school community.


