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## **Junior Newsletter**

Our Junior grades have been very busy over the past few weeks. To begin the term, we have been focussing on Numbers! Place value, counting groups, making groups, partitioning and comparing groups!

Our Prep students have been practising hearing sounds in words and developing their ability to rhyme. We have read lots of rhyming books including Dr Seuss and the Hairy Maclary series and made-up lots of silly rhymes.

Our Grade 1/2 students have been sequencing the events of different stories, recognising "cause and effect" within the narrative and then using this information to make predictions about the characters and plot.

To complement our Reading topics, Grade 1/2 have also been honing their skills writing narratives. Our focus has been on developing our ideas and using the trait of Voice in our writing.

Meanwhile, we have learnt many new sounds and their symbols in Prep – concentrating on letter formation, and connecting the sounds to the symbols both visually and in our handwriting.

### Things to do:

- → **Practise hearing rhymes in stories** make up some silly rhymes to say with your children.
- → Blue Communication Satchel thank you for being so diligent with these. Please continue to ensure this comes to school each day and check it when it comes home after school for any important notices.







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






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## 3/4 Newsletter

We have been learning so much over the last few weeks. The students have settled into the routines and expectations of the 3/4 area.

In our Reading sessions, we have been practising our reading strategies and applying them to our whole class novel, Charlotte's Web as well as to our guided reading texts. We are learning to identify character traits, settings, plots, as well as working on dictionary meanings of words and alphabetical order in our texts, just to name a few.

In Writing we have been working on narrative writing and using the mentor text Claudette and Felipe, written by Mark Teague. The students have been learning about the importance of developing character traits, setting and plot.







It has been a very busy time in Maths as the students have been working very hard to complete their initial assessments on the computer. Most of the students are now finished and we have moved on to skip counting and the many strategies that we can use.





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In Inquiry, the students are learning about rules and laws and how they may differ between homes, schools, councils and states.












