Last year, the school was allocated significant funding to undertake essential roof repairs. This project is being managed by the Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA), who will oversee all works to ensure they are completed safely and in line with department and building requirements.

The process of appointing a builder has now been finalised. Site establishment will begin on Friday 13 March, with construction works commencing on Monday 16 March.

While works will occur across several areas of the school, the building currently housing our Grade 3/4 students will have the entire roof replaced. As a result, Grade 3/4 students will be temporarily relocated to an alternative classroom for the duration of the project to minimise disruption to teaching and learning.

It has come to my attention that there is currently a back order of school hats at our uniform supplier, Beleza School Uniforms. While this issue is being resolved, families are encouraged to purchase a legionnaire or broad-brimmed hat in the school colours from alternative retailers such as Kmart Australia or Best & Less. Ensuring students have an appropriate hat for outdoor activities is essential as we continue to follow our SunSmart practices.



Our **School Council** plays a vital role in shaping the direction of our school. It brings together parents, staff and community members to work collaboratively in supporting student learning, wellbeing and the effective governance of the school.


